- 17- 1W+1cnr+2cnr repeat [9–16] (2,1,3)
- 25- 1c turn 1cnrs RHI pass RSh; turn 2cnrs RHI pass RShto 2pl (2,1,3)



- 9-16 1s dance 6 bar reels of 3 on opposite sides (1s in/down, 2s out/down, 3s out/up to start), 1s turn LH to face 1st corners
- 17-24 1s turn 1st corner RH, partner LH, 2nd corner RH& cross LH to own sides
- 25-32 All circle 6H round & back

- 9- All A&R; ½ Reels3 across (Lsh to 1cnr) (2x,1x,3x)
- 17- All A&R; ½ Reels3 across (Lsh to 3cnr pos), 1c finish LHJ with P and RHJ with 4cnr
- the Spoke: BiL{1}, advance LHJ cclw to next cnr {1} I repeat 3 times, on [31–32] 1c petronella turn to (2,1,3)



1s dance a reel of three accross with 2s and 3s, 1st man down, 1st lady up, to 3, 1, 2.


## **Tourbillon**

- Bar 1 1st Lady and 2nd Man Take Both hands with Partners, Turn halfway and release Partners' left Hands, Finishing Facing Up and Down;
- Bar 2 retaining Nearer hands Hold, all Travel clockwise around the rectangle formed by their Starting Places to Finish On the sides Facing Inwards, 1st Lady and 2nd Man in their Starting Places;
- Bars 3-4 1st Couple, on the Ladies' Side, Set Facing 2nd Couple, on the Men's Side;
- Bar 5 1st Man and 2nd Lady Take Both hands with Partners, Turn halfway and release Partners' left Hands, Finishing Facing Up and Down;
- Bar 6 retaining Nearer hands Hold, all Travel clockwise around the rectangle formed by their Starting Places to Finish On the sides Facing Inwards, all on Opposite sides, 2nd Couple now in 1st Place;
- Bars 7-8 all Cross By the right to Finish on Own side

## 8 THE BEES OF MAGGIEKNOCKATER J32 · 4/4L

- 1- 1c cross RHI cast off (2c up);1c+3c RHA,finish as pairs 1M+3W & 3M+1W facing out on W/M side in promhold
- 9- Pairs+ 2c+4c Rsh ½Reels3on sides ; pairs meet & take P in promhold for Lsh ½Reels3on sides
- 17- Meet and repeat (as pairs Rsh ½Reels3; with P Lsh ½Reels3)
- 25- 1c (passing inside) turn 3c 1½ EasyHand ;1c cross and passing inside turn 4c EH 1½ (to 2,3,4,1)



- 1- 1c turn RHI cast (2c up); turn LH to face 1cnrs
- 9- 1c ½Reel4with 1cnrs (pass P Lsh); Repeat with 2cnrs
- 17- Repeat with 3cnrs (1cnr person); Repeat with 4cnrs (2cnr person)
- 25- 1W+2c & 1M+3c Reels3 across, Lsh to 1cnr
- 33- 2c+1c+3c circle6 and back

Note: Cosh explicitly tells 1c to pass Lsh in [9–24]; however the Rsh pass is quite common, and sometimes nicknamed "Mairi's Divorce".





- 1- 1c+3c turn RH½ with person opposite, face that person I twirl R and into opposite place; 2c+4c repeat this and face in while{4}1c+3c (W leading) chase ¼ clw I curve into centre and swivel Rto face out (1c facing 4pl and 3c facing 2pl)
- 9- Parallel Reels4 across
- 17- 2c+1c & 3c+4c circle4 L; face other couple and set I ½ RHA, flowing into
- 25- 2c+4c LHA in the middle; dance out passing same sex standing dancer on the side Rsh, and chase R(M leading) to 1pl/3pl (to 2,3,4,1).





- 9-16 2s+4s chase anticlockwise 1/2 way round 3s, 4s+3s+2s chase anticlockwise 1/2 way. (5)2(3)2(1)
- 17-24 5s dance Fig of 8 on sides round 2s+3s while1s dance Fig of 8 on sides round 4s+3s (5s & 1s giving LSh to start)
- 25-32 5s+3s+1s cross RH to own sides & 3s cast up to 1st place while 1s cast up to 4th place & all turn RH.3 5 2

- 25-28 1s & 3s dance 1/2 Fig 8 through the couple above (1s through 2s, 4s through 3s)
